

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2018

Scholarships are granted through Grand River Health and Grand River Hospital District Volunteer Association

- 1. **Eight Scholarships** in the amount of \$1000 (*non-renewable*) and will be given to students planning to study in a health care related field (nursing, radiology, pathology, pre-med, etc.).
- 2. **Two GRH Volunteer Scholarships** are available in the amount of \$2000 (non-renewable) and will be given to volunteers who have completed at least 50 hours of service or more at Grand River Health and are planning to study in one of the many health care related field (nursing, radiology, pathology, pre-med, etc.).

All scholarships must be used in the fall of 2018 at any college, university, or technical school which offers the coursework necessary for the chosen medical field. The scholarship is to be used for tuition, books, room and board or other fees necessary for attendance at one of the aforementioned institutions.

Award will be paid to the institution of your choice, not to the recipient of the scholarship.

WHO MAY APPLY?

Any person who lives in Grand River Hospital District or is a student in one of the three in-district high schools (*Rifle, Grand Valley or Coal Ridge*), who wishes to pursue a career in the medical field, and is planning to attend a college, university or technical school in the fall of 2018. This includes graduating high school seniors, individuals who have previously graduated high school, and GRH employees. Awards will be given only to individuals who have not previously received a scholarship from Grand River Health.

HOW TO APPLY:

- 1. Complete the Application. Make sure your application is complete. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 2. Submit an Essay of approximately 500 words, which explains why you have chosen the health field you wish to study. (On separate page)
- 3. Short answer (approximately 150 words): Thus far, what has been the proudest moment of your life?
- 4. Attach two (2) letters of recommendation. *At least one of these letters must be from outside the school system, and both should be from someone other than a family member.*
- 5. Enclose your most recent copy of your high school or college transcript, unofficial accepted.
- 6. Mail, email or deliver all information to the following address prior to the deadline: April 2, 2018 @ noon

- 1. Your completed application.
- 2. Two (2) letters of recommendation (from people other than family members, one of which should be from outside the school system)
- 3. Your typewritten essay, about 500 words long, which must explain why you have decided to pursue the medical career for which you will study. Plus your short answer paragraph (about 150 words).
- 4. A copy of your current high school / college transcript (can be unofficial).
